We make sure you cover the most distance returning by water taxi so there is no need to paddle back to the start of your kayak journey. Join us for a unique personalised journey into the heart of Fiordland.

Points of difference:

- ✂ 4 hours kayaking on Doubtful Sound

- ✂ Return by boat from the end of Hall Arm to Deep Cove (kayak one way only, covering the most distance)
- ✂ All transport from Te Anau and cruise from Manapouri are included

Timeline:

- 6:30 am meet at our office in Te Anau.
- 7:00 am leave by bus to Manapouri and cruise across Lake Manapouri to West Arm.
- 8:45 am travel over the Wilmot Pass Road for 22 km by coach with scenic stops along the way.
- 9:30 am arrive at Deep Cove, get into your kayak and paddle into amazing Doubtful Sound.
- 11:30 am lunch break on vessel.
- 12:00 pm more kayaking. Explore the sheltered coves and shorelines, get close to nature.
- 2:45 pm our vessel will pick you up from the end of your paddle and return by boat to Deep Cove.
- 5:15 pm arrive in Manapouri and 5:30 pm arrive in Te Anau.

What is supplied:

- ✓ All kayak gear, Wetsuit, Paddle-Jackets and Life Jacket
- ✓ Spray skirts
- ✓ Polypropylene clothing
- ✓ Rain jackets
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Pogies (paddling gloves)
- ✓ Dry camera bags
- ✓ Modern and stable Double Sea-Kayak equipped with steering rudders, padded seat and safety gear
- ✓ Hot drinks and biscuits

What to bring:

- Swimwear/underwear (for under the wetsuit)
- Spare soft shoes & warm socks (to use in the kayak)
- Raincoat plus warm jacket/fleece
- Change of clothes & towel
- Sunblock, sunglasses & sunhat
- Insect repellent
- Water bottle or drink
- Lunch and snacks
- Camera with memory-card
- Medications

POLICY: A minimum of 4 kayakers are required per departure. As the kayak cockpit is a fixed size, weight limit of 115kg. HOWEVER Kayakers who are wider at the hips or who have long legs please call and speak with us to discuss if it will be practical to fit into a kayak. Children 14 years minimum age – children must have kayaked some distance before. Each child must be traveling with a strong adult (as they will be in a double kayak with parent) and be at least 1.4 metres tall and at least 45 kg in weight. If cancellation occurs within 7 days of departure, there is no refund. OffSpring Travel LTD reserves all rights.

Cancellation Policy: Payment is part refundable (less 10% fee) if cancelled more than 14 days prior to departure. No refund if cancellation is made within or less than 14 days of departure.
