



Doubtful Sound Kayak Full Day Tour is designed to maximise the distance you travel, and the time spent on the water of Doubtful Sound. Kayak with us and experience Doubtful Sound from sea level. During your 4 hours Kayaking explore the nature from Deep Cove to Hall Arm. We make sure you cover the most distance returning by water taxi, no need to paddle back to the start of your journey.

Your Journey:

- ✚ 6.30am Meet at our office, located at Te Anau Lakeview Holiday Park, 77 Manapouri-Te Anau Highway. Here we will collect kayaking gear and go over safety procedures.
- ✚ 7.00am leave Te Anau for Manapouri and your cruise across Lake Manapouri to West Arm
- ✚ 8.45am Travel over the Wilmot Pass Road for 22km by coach with stops along the way
- ✚ 9.45am arrive at Deep Cove and paddle into amazing Doubtful Sound
- ✚ 11.30am Lunch on vessel
- ✚ 12.00pm Continue kayaking
- ✚ 2.45pm our vessel will pick you up from the end of the paddle and return by cruise to Deep Cove
- ✚ 5.15pm Arrive back in Manapouri
- ✚ 5.30pm Arrive back in Te Anau

What is supplied:

- ✓ Wetsuit vest, Paddle-Jackets and Life Jacket
- ✓ Spray skirts
- ✓ Polypropylene clothing
- ✓ Rain jackets
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Pogies (paddling gloves)
- ✓ Dry camera bags
- ✓ Modern and stable Double Sea-Kayak equipped with steering rudders, clean paddling and safety gear

What to bring:

- Swimwear/underwear (for under the wetsuit)
- Spare soft shoes & warm socks (to use in the kayak)
- Raincoat plus warm jacket/fleece
- Change of clothes
- Towel
- Sunblock, sunglasses & sunhat
- Insect repellent
- Water bottle or drink
- Lunch and snacks
- Camera with memory-card
- Medications

*IMPORTANT NOTES: A minimum of 2 kayakers are required per departure. As the kayak cockpit is a fixed size, to ensure 'fit' into our kayaks we impose a weight limit of 115kg. HOWEVER, kayakers who are wider at the hips or who have long legs please call and speak with us to discuss if it will be practical to fit into a kayak. Children 14 years minimum age – children must have kayaked some distance before. Each child must be traveling with a strong adult (as they will be in a double kayak with parent) and be at least 1.4 metres tall and at least 45 kg in weight. Please come prepared for both wet/cold and fine weather as conditions can be changeable throughout the day. Kayaking distance is approximate only and may change subject to weather, kayakers' capabilities & safety considerations on the day. If cancellation occurs within 7 days of departure, there is no refund. OffSpring Travel LTD reserves all rights.
